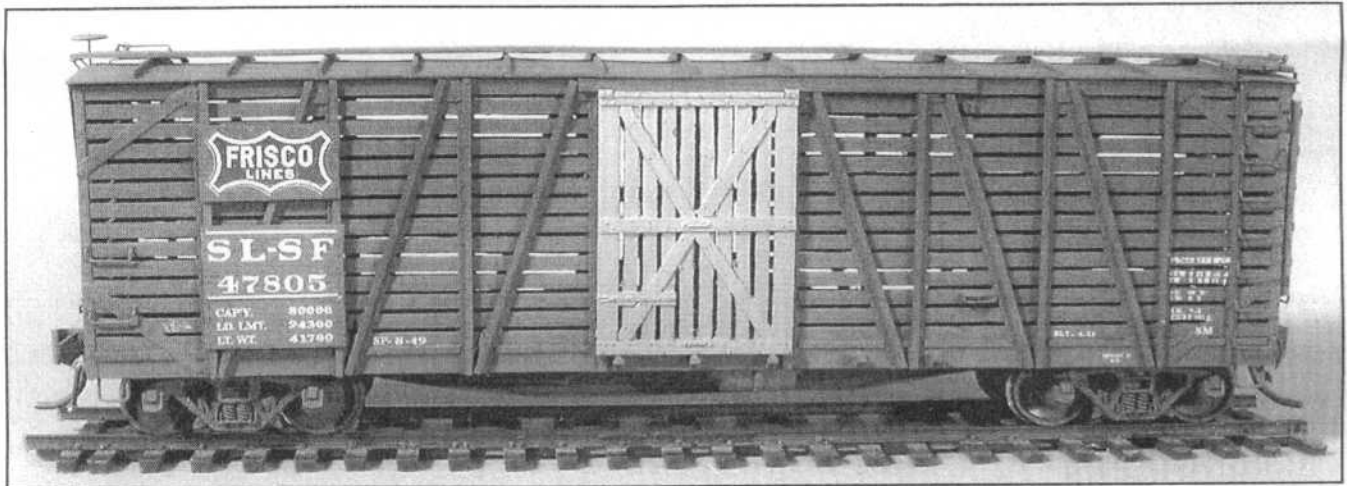
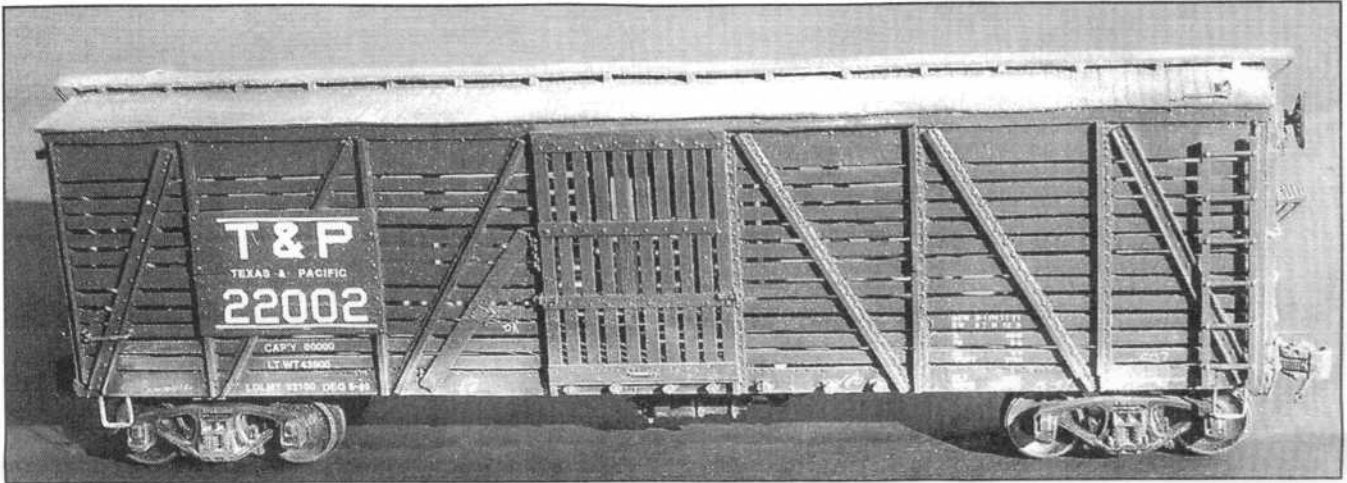


Midwest Stockcars

T&P 22000 and SL-SF 47700 Series



Two roads widely associated with the movement of livestock were the Texas and Pacific and Frisco. The T&P served the vast cattle country of west Texas, while the Frisco crisscrossed Kansas and Oklahoma and reached well into northern and mid Texas. The T&P's west Texas stock operation was oriented toward the West and California. The SL-SF was oriented toward the Midwest stockyards—Kansas City and St. Louis. Other uses were to move plains stock to the meadows of the Rockies or Pennsylvania for summer grazing and to carry watermelons throughout the U.S.

The T&P stockcar fleet in the late steam era consisted of 500 cars in the 22000 series. Purchased in 1929 from Pullman, the single deck cars had a steel frame, composite ends, and a wood tongue in

groove roof. The door opening was 6' to accommodate the larger cattle of Texas. There were 496 cars in 1946.

The SL-SF 47700 series stockcars were an add-on to the 145550 series boxcars of 1923. They used the truly unique Samson roof—a radial design—and unlike the boxcars this roof remained in use throughout the life of the stockcars. The cars also used fully slatted ends. There were 296 of the original 300 cars in 1948.

The Sunshine kits are vacuum cast in gray urethane. Kits include all detailing parts (except trucks and couplers) and proprietary decals. Full instructions and a Prototype Data Sheet are included.

The correct trucks--ARA cast side frame--are available separately. Appropriate chalkmarks are available also.
